**WINS opens in September with kindergarten, elementary and middle schools** in brand new spaces, planned and designed to accommodate children from 2.5 years old up to the age of 18, complete with **swimming pool, gym, library, music rooms, laboratories, canteen, auditorium, outdoor amphitheatre and a garden** of about 4.600 square meters with **sports facilities and teaching spaces**. The area is that of the J Village, not far from the Juventus stadium, in an area that has been redesigned and renovated following an ambitious development plan.

The training centre is inspired by the International Baccalaureate® (IB), an international method recognized in Italy and around the world, for its innovative and inspiring experiential approach. **Paolo Formiga**, the founder and CEO of the **WINS**, whose family has been involved with education within international schools since 1958, explains: "*WINS is an international school, promoting respect and freedom, it aims at enhancing the natural aptitudes of children growing up in a cosmopolitan, avant-garde environment so they may become citizens of the world, in the world.*"

In other words, **the excellence of a boarding school** in preparing young people from all points of view, where **natural curiosity, critical thinking and the ability to act and grow** in an increasingly global world, connected and rapidly changing are encouraged.

**Patrizia Groppo**, **WINS** School Manager, comments "We can count on an expertise in the industry that has no equal in Italy, as has been demonstrated by the **50 years** of the Formiga family's activities, on a team of **native English-speaking teachers**, with experience in worldwide international schools, who take into the classroom a **constructive coaching and mentoring approach** rather than a teacher-learner approach, promoting the desire to learn and explore the world."

Students of the World International School will be able to count on an important project: A **Digital Learning Experience** which aims to smartly integrate technology at the service of the school. There are also innovative extracurricular activities such as sports, artistic-creative activities and cognitive science activities.
